Palm, or Passion, Sunday begins the most sacred week of the Church year—Holy Week. During these days, we prepare ourselves for Easter by prayerful reflection upon the events of Jesus' Passion and death. You might display a crucifix in a prominent place this week, as reminder of the salvation Christ won for us. The crucifix can also be the focal point for family prayer during Holy Week.

Because of the length and complexity of the Passion narrative, young children have difficulty remaining attentive when it is proclaimed in its entirety. Families can choose to read a portion of this Sunday's Gospel each day of Holy Week, providing ample opportunity for children to ask questions and respond to the events described there. In this way, the entire week can become a "way of the cross."

Each day during Holy Week, the family can gather in a prayerful space with a crucifix as the focal point. The Passion as found in Matthew's Gospel might be read as follows throughout the week:

Sunday: Matthew 21:11-11 (Gospel at the Procession with Palms)

Monday: Matthew 26:14-25 Tuesday: Matthew 26:26-35 Wednesday: Matthew 26:36-56 Thursday: Matthew 26:57-27:14 Friday: Matthew 27:15-54

After reading from the Gospel each night, the family might reflect on the reading together. Conclude your prayer time together by praying the Lord's Prayer and/or singing an appropriate hymn, such as "Jesus, Jesus," "Were You There?" or "What Wondrous Love Is This."





THE EASTER TRIDDUM-BEGINS WITH THE EVENING MASS OF THE LORD'S SUPPER ON MAUNDAY THURSDAY, REACHING ITS HIGH POINT IN THE EASTER VIGIL, AND CLOSES WITH EVENING PRAYER ON EASTER SUNDAY, IS THE SUMMIT OF THE LITURGICAL YEAR. IT COMMEMORATES CHRIST'S PASCHAL MYSTERY, I.E., THE PASSION, DEATH, AND RESURRECTION OF JESUS.



### **HOLY THURSDAY (We remember)**

"Solemn Celebration of the Lord's Supper" 7:00 p.m. Commemorates the day Jesus instituted the Eucharist, the Sacred Priesthood and the call to service by the washing of feet.

### GOOD FRIDAY (We celebrate)

"Stations of the Cross" 3:00 p.m. Recreates the scenes to and on Calvary, we are called to walk with Jesus along the Via Crucis. "Solemn Celebration of the Lord's Passion" 7:00 p.m. Commemorates the execution of Jesus on the Cross. This special day is a day of FAST (& Abstinence) which means we abstain from meat and from eating between meals-a day of special remembrance and observance of the Passion and Death of the Lord.

## PONTIFICAL GOOD FRIDAY COLLECTION

March 29, 2023

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Soon, our diocese will take up a collection for the **Pontifical Good Friday Collection** on **April 7**. For **800** years, the Holy Land Franciscans have served in the land made holy by the life, suffering, death, and resurrection of Jesus. With your support, the Holy Land Franciscans will continue to nourish Christians in the Holy Land with presence, care, and service.

Fully 100 % of donations will go towards this collection. A portion of your contributions are allocated to educational and ecclesial projects in the Middle East. The rest of the funds collected in the United States and other countries around the world support ministries and programs in the Holy Land.

Last year's Pontifical Good Friday Collection accomplishments:

- Supported 23 parishes and three academic institutions
- Provided a home for 30 children from homes facing domestic violence
- Offered **500** scholarships for university education
- Helped keep schools open for over 10,000 pre-K through grade 12 students
- Supported 53 men preparing for the priesthood
- Restored and maintained 640 houses/apartments for Christian families
- Provided assistance to more than **9,000** families through weekly food baskets
- Employed more than 1,000 workers in the Holy Land
- Preserved 80 shrines connected with the life of Jesus and the prophets

# ST. DOMINIC'S

BOARDING HOUSE HOLY FAMILY'S INTERNATIONAL OUTREACH MINISTRY The 2022-2023 academic year just finished with 30 boys completing their schooling and religious training at St. Dominic's. Due to Covid and the Military Coup, these past tow years Fr. Daniel and the boys have feared for their

lives, seen much of the St. Dominic's budlings and contents be destroyed along with the nearby public school. The older boys have stayed in hiding as they continue to be forced into the military or guerilla forces. We have been able to send donations to them for the past year although they have to be very careful in receiving our donations in fear of military and ad hoc government intercepting the funds.

St. Dominic's has been able to slowly replace destroyed items, beds, chairs and cooking utensils. The biggest replacement was to be able to build a new water tub for cooking and drinking. As Fr. Daniel says, "Thank you all for your continual support and prayers. We live in constant fear. Without your support we would not be able to continue." Their staff is down to a music teacher, Fr. Daniel, and one cook. We ask for your continued prayers and will keep you updated over the next few weeks.


