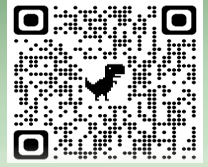

Today's Gospel reminds us that in order for God's Word to take root in us and produce abundant fruit, we must endeavor to be like good soil. Families, in particular, hold the responsibility for "preparing the soil" so that the seeds of God's Word can grow strong. There are many ways in which families do this—family traditions in which faith is celebrated, prayer and reading of Scripture, and instruction on the faith. In these ways, parents fulfill the promises they made at their child's Baptism.

Gather together as a family and reflect together on the Sacrament of Baptism. Tell the story of the Baptism of each child, showing any pictures that were taken. If you have your child's Baptism candle or gown, share these as well. Recall together that one of the promises that parents make at their child's Baptism is to bring them up in the practice of our faith. Talk together about the importance of this promise to your family. Then read together today's Gospel, Matthew 13:1-23. Reflect together on the ways in which your family practices your faith (daily prayer, Mass attendance, religious instruction, etc.). Remind one another that we do these things as a family so that God's Word can take root in our lives and produce abundant fruit. Conclude in prayer together by praying today's Psalm, Psalm 65.

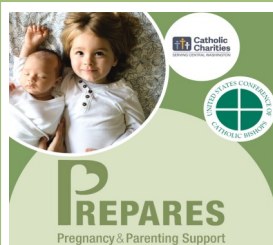

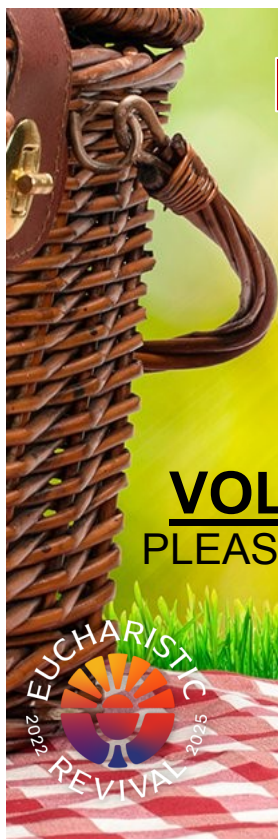

## SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

### BAPTISMS

Holy Baptism is the basis of the whole Christian life, the gateway to life in the Spirit (vitae spiritualis ianua), and the door which gives access to the other sacraments. Through Baptism we are freed from sin and reborn as sons of God; we become members of Christ, are incorporated into the church and made sharers in her mission;

#### To schedule a baptism:

##### Children (ages 0 to 6)

Birth Certificate

If not registered member letter from home parish granting permission to baptize here.

##### Godparents:

16 years of age, Completed Sacraments of Initiation

If living with someone shall be married through the Catholic Faith.

##### Children 7 years old through adulthood

Participate in OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults) for more information call the parish office.



### EUCHARIST SACRAMENTAL PREP

Designed for those who have yet to complete their First Communion and who have attended Religious Education for at least one year and are in 2nd grade or above.

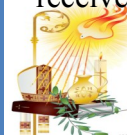

## The Reinstatement of the Distribution of the Precious Blood



Dear beloved Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Given this time of Eucharistic Renewal and remembering that the Eucharist is the source and summit of our faith, Given that the state of emergency due to the COVID-19 pandemic has been lifted, nationwide and statewide, and that danger of the spread of the virus has decreased to a minor scale, And after prayerful discernment, and in extensive consultation with clergy and laity of the Diocese regarding the reception of the Precious Blood, I

### DECREE

that, *effective August 15, 2023*, during the Solemnity of The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, all parishes will once again offer ***Holy Communion under both species***. The Precious Blood of Christ is to be administered to the faithful at Sunday Masses (and the Vigil) and, weekday Masses, if that has been the practice in the past.

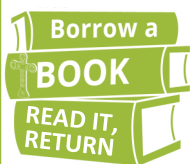

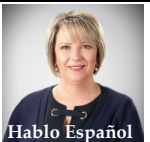
