





BAPTISMSHoly Baptism is the basis of the whole Christian life, the gateway to life in the Spirit (vitae spiritualis ianua), and the door which gives access to the other sacraments. Through Baptism we are freed from sin and reborn as sons of God; we become members of Christ, are incorporated into the church and made sharers in her mission;

To schedule a baptism:

Children (ages 0 to 6)

Birth Certificate

If not registered member letter from home parish granting permission to baptize here.

Godparents:

16 years of age, Completed Sacraments of Initiation If living with someone shall be married through the Catholic Faith.

Children 7 years old through adulthood

Participate in OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults) for more information call the parish office.






