

In an ideal household, family members know the rules and follow them consistently. Even the most conscientious among us, however, sometimes needs to be reminded of the rules and their importance. How we respond to such correction reveals our true character. In today's Gospel Jesus exposes the religious leaders for their failure to heed God's messengers. It is an opportunity for us to consider how we respond to those who are God's messengers today, calling us to correct our ways and return to the way of the Lord.

As you gather as a family, talk about some of the most important rules of your household. Consider how consistently family members follow these rules. How are family members reminded when rules are not being followed? How do they respond? In today's Gospel Jesus corrects the religious leaders through a parable telling them that they have not heeded God's messengers. Read Matthew 21:33-43. What are some of God's rules that we must follow? How do we respond to God's messengers today? Pray together as a family that you will heed God's messengers and follow God's ways. Pray together the Act of Contrition for the times when your family has not heeded God's word.

EVANGELIZATION

Vision

The Christian Journey begins as an encounter with the Living God. We respond to this experience by freely opening our lives to a relationship with the indwelling presence of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. This relationship heals us and moves us in community to spiritual growth and service within our churches and the larger community.

EVANGELIZATION RETREAT <u>Mission</u>

The Evangelization Retreat provides the people of God with an opportunity within the parish setting for an intense and ongoing encounter with their God.

Goals

Retreat:

- Retreatants praise and worship in song, share scripture reading, and hear testimonies by fellow parishioners of their journey of faith.
- Retreatants share in small groups that draw out and validate each other's experience of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- Retreatants participate in the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist, and other prayer experiences.

Community Groups

Retreatants come together in small weekly community groups and monthly catechesis to continue to nurture personal growth in faith and community outreach after the retreat.

About the Retreat

The retreat is planned, organized and conducted by lay people under the guidance and authority of the pastor. We spend 6 - 8 weeks preparing for the retreat. During the last six weeks we gather every Friday evening for Prayer and Praise, so that we are constantly aware of our need for the Holy Spirit and whose work we do. The retreat itself begins on Friday evening and concludes on Sunday afternoon with retreatants going home at night and returning early each morning. The retreat format closely follows a book by Fr. Alfonso Navarro, Evangelization: God's Love for Man.

The Evangelization Retreat is about conversion:

It is about evangelizing the church. It is not so much a program as it is a grace. It focuses upon the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Reconciliation, Confirmation, and Eucharist, whereby we become converted. Whereby, we become witnesses. Whereby, we recognize our need for community and our call to mission. It is a matter of the heart, not the head.

Common Questions and Answers about the Retreat

Is there a cost associated with this retreat?

There will be a Free-will offering taken up during the retreat to cover the cost of food and other expenses. We do not want cost to be a barrier for attending the retreat. If a suggested donation would be helpful, \$60.00 will be most appropriate. In addition to the suggested donation, retreat shirts will be sold during the weekend for retreatants and team members. Prices of shirts and sizes are included on the registration form. Evangelization shirts are worn on Sunday of the retreat and any time thereafter.

What if I can't attend the full retreat?

There is a portion of this retreat that will take place in small groups. It does not work well for people to attend only parts of the retreat. The retreat moves from one theme to the next and builds throughout the weekend. If you are unable to attend the full retreat, we recommend that you wait until the next retreat is offered.

Is child care provided?

Due to lack of suitable space, we are unable to provide good child care for the weekend retreat.

What about Mass during the retreat?


The retreatants and those conducting the retreat participate in the regular Sunday Liturgy with the rest of the parish. Retreatants are also encouraged to attend Mass on Saturday morning before the retreat begins.

THE SHOCKING TRUTH

Jesus said, "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life." This teaching was so shocking that many of his followers left at that moment! Jesus did not call them back to clarify, because he knew they understood correctly. He was actually telling them to eat his flesh and drink his blood.

As Catholics, we believe Jesus' words literally, not symbolically. The substance of the bread and wine transform into the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ at every Mass. We call this miracle the Eucharist.

BAPTISMS
Holy Baptism is the basis of the whole Christian life, the gateway to life in the Spirit (vitae spiritualis ianua), and the door which gives access to the other sacraments. Through Baptism we are freed from sin and reborn as sons of God; we become members of Christ, are incorporated into the church and made sharers in her mission;

Godparents:

16 years of age, Completed Sacraments of Initiation If living with someone shall be married through the Catholic Faith.
