Not only can we recognize family members' voices, we can also read the tone of their voices and know something about how they are feeling. In our relationship with Jesus, we know Jesus' voice and are called to follow. Jesus doesn't just bring us closer to the Father, Jesus puts us directly into contact with God the Father, removing all distance between us. In the Gospel of John, Jesus identifies so closely with the Father that he tells us that they are one—not just close, but actually one. Knowing Jesus means knowing the Father.



#### **Mass of Anointing of the Sick & Luncheon**

Who Can Receive the Anointing of the Sick:

- Canon 1004 §1: Anyone who is seriously ill or elderly and understands what's happening (has reached the age of reason) can receive the Anointing of the Sick.
- Canon 1004 §2: The sacrament can be given more than once—if the person gets sick again after recovering, or if their condition becomes worse during the same illness.
- Canon 1005: If there's doubt about whether the person understands, is seriously ill, or has already died, the sacrament should still be given.
- Canon 1006: If someone requested the sacrament (even indirectly) while they were mentally aware, they can receive it when they are sick.
- Canon 1007: The sacrament should not be given to people who openly and stubbornly continue in serious sin.

All those in need of physical, mental, or spiritual healing are invited to a special Healing Mass, offered on the second Tuesday of each month in our Chapel. Join us afterward in the Gathering Hall for a meal. Please RSVP to 509-966-0830
