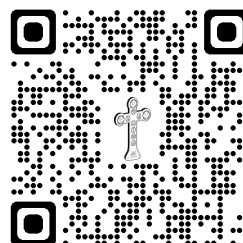

One can tell a lot about a family by the way they welcome others into their home. Despite parental efforts to elicit the best behavior from their children, family efforts to entertain guests are sometimes difficult. Practicing a spirit of Christian hospitality within the family can be an occasion to reflect upon the importance of this virtue. A family spirit of hospitality is a sign of faith.

When your family gathers, ask each person to consider the following questions about manners: What does it mean to be a good host? What does it mean to be a good guest? Invite each person to share their thoughts and experiences about being a guest or a host. When they have finished, read aloud today's Gospel, Matthew 10:37-42.

Ask family members to describe what Jesus says about hospitality extended to his disciples. (Those who receive Jesus' disciples also receive Jesus himself; hospitality to Jesus' disciples will be rewarded.) Then encourage family members to talk about what it means to be a good guest or a good host. You might also talk about ways in which your family's hospitality might be improved upon. Conclude in prayer together that your family grows to be one in which Christian hospitality is experienced by all. Pray together the Lord's Prayer or today's Psalm.

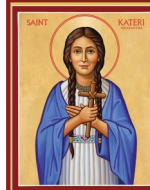

SCAN ME

from Scripture Matthew 10:37-42, The priorities of discipleship

In this Gospel passage, Jesus speaks clearly about the demands of discipleship. At its heart is the question of priorities. For the early Christians, following Christ often meant risking imprisonment, persecution, or even death. To belong to Jesus required complete trust and surrender because only God is worthy of first place in our hearts and lives. Faithful Catholic life still carries challenges today. Much of what Christ and His Church ask of us runs counter to the values of secular culture. Even apart from worldly pressures, each of us carries personal crosses — struggles, sacrifices, disappointments, and suffering. Yet Jesus never asks us to carry them alone. He invites us to follow Him and to walk beside Him through them. The good news is that Jesus has already gone before us — from suffering to glory, from death to eternal life, and from sorrow to joy. Because of Him, our crosses are no longer meaningless. With His grace, we can choose each day to remain faithful, keep His commandments, and abide in His love. One day, in Heaven, we will see clearly that every sacrifice made for Christ was worth it.

Through Baptism we are freed from sin and reborn as sons of God; we become members of Christ, are incorporated into the Church and made sharers in her mission;

If living with someone, married through the Catholic Faith (*Marriage Certificate*)

Children 7 years old through adulthood

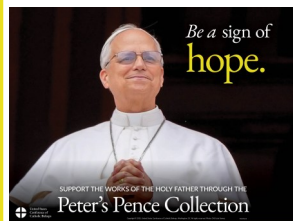

Diocese of Yakima PLANNING STUDY

HELP SHAPE THE FUTURE OF OUR DIOCESE

The Diocese of Yakima is prayerfully discerning how best to strengthen our ministries, support our parishes, and prepare the Church in Central Washington for the future. As part of this discernment, we are conducting a planning study to listen to parishioners, clergy, and lay leaders across the diocese. This is a continuation of the consultations that began with our Parish visitations in 2014, what we learned from you during the Synod process, and observations gained from ministries over the past 12 years.

What is a planning study?

A planning study is a time of listening. It gives members of our diocesan family an opportunity to share their thoughts as we consider important ministry priorities and the best path forward. Your feedback will help guide thoughtful, faith-filled decisions about the future of the Diocese of Yakima.

How is the study being conducted?

The Steier Group, a national Catholic fundraising firm, is assisting with the study. All responses are confidential and will be shared only in summary form. Some parishioners may be invited to participate in a brief personal interview. Others will be asked to complete a survey by mail or online. The online survey link is steiergroup.com/survey.

Why are we doing this now?

After prayerful reflection and consultation with clergy and lay leaders, several important priorities have emerged for the future of our diocese. Before taking the next step, we want to listen carefully to the people of the Diocese of Yakima.

At this time, we ask for your prayers and your honest feedback. When invited, please take a few minutes to participate in the planning study. Together, we can strengthen our Church, support one another, and help build a stronger future for the Diocese of Yakima.

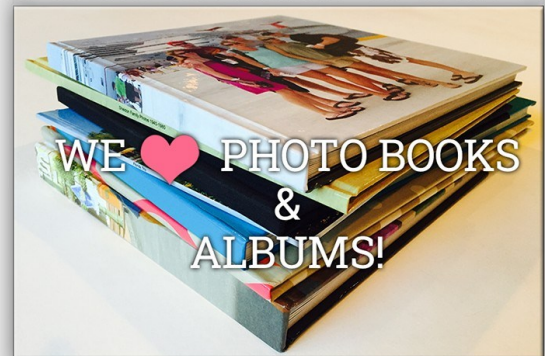
Watch the bulletin for upcoming events and registration information (beginning in July) for the 2026-2027 programs.
