St. Peter's Financial Report

Copies of the financial report are available in the back of the church. Thanks to you, our Sunday Collection is up about \$13,000. We are blessed to have such wonderful people here at St. Peter's.

The \$70,000 item on the report is the sale of the High Falls Chapel. We did need to replace 2 boilers on the property and did some roof repair work on the school. Our expenses were down mainly thanks to low fuel expenses for the past year. Our total income for the year was \$337,390 and our total expenses were \$297,120.36.
