THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD + MAY 18

Jesus' Ascension into Heaven is the completion of His mission on earth. He came not only to save us through His Passion, death, and Resurrection, but also to establish Himself as our continual intercessor. He did this by ascending into Heaven and taking His place at the right hand of His Father. He is forever united to human nature and, having taken His seat in Heaven, continues to act as the Mediator between God and man.

From His place in Heaven, Jesus continually reaches down to earth in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. Through the priest, who acts in His person, He offers to His Father the perfect and priceless Sacrifice of Himself for us sinners—all over the world, at every hour of every day.

So the Ascension is the celebration of the completion of our redemption, the triumphant arrival of our King in His kingdom, and His intercession for us. What a cause for celebration indeed!

Of course, Jesus also ascended to show us where—if we live in imitation of Him—we too are destined. We are meant to be with Him in Heaven, if we love Him and follow His commandments.

The Feast of the Ascension is celebrated on the 40th day of Easter, always a Thursday. (getfed.catholiccompany.com)

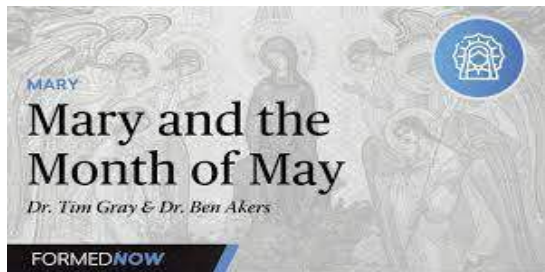

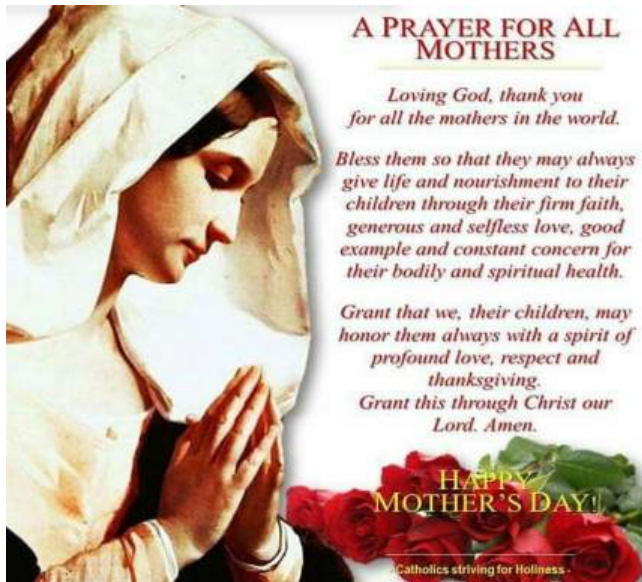
