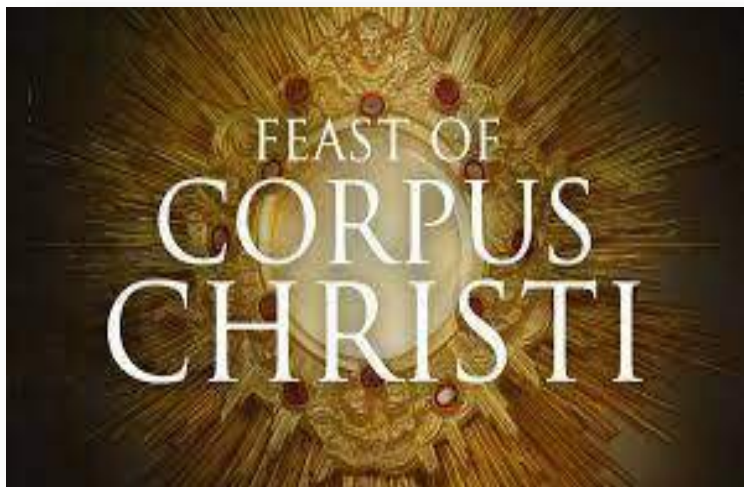

TODAY - For the **Feast of Corpus Christi**, June 10-11, the Blessed Sacrament will be Exposed 4-5PM Saturday afternoon, June 10th, in the church during Confessions ending with Benediction just before the 5PM Mass.

And again, we will have Exposition from the end of the 9:30AM Mass on Sunday, June 11th, ending with Benediction just before the 11:30AM Mass. Join us!

WHAT DOES THE SOLEMNITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI CELEBRATE?

Also known as the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, this feast honors Jesus Christ, Really, Truly and Substantially Present under the appearances of bread and wine. This Presence happens through the change which the Church calls transubstantiation ("change of substance"), when at the Consecration of the Mass, the priest says the words which Christ Himself pronounced over bread and wine, "This is My Body," "This is the chalice of My Blood," "Do this in remembrance of Me."



As part of the last year of the **NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL**, (June 19, 2022 – June 11, 2023), our Archdiocese is responding to the Lord's personal invitation by preparing a vast array of eucharistic events for the faithful. THE 2023 CARDINAL'S APPEAL

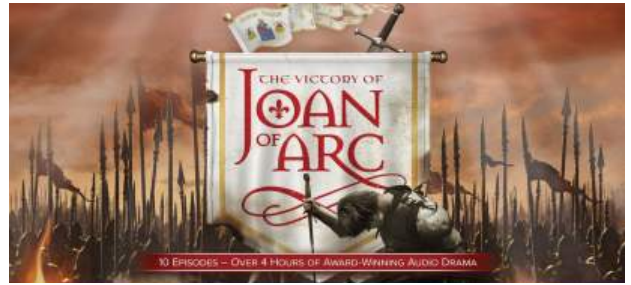
At its core, the Appeal exists to fund the vast educational, charitable, and pastoral outreach of our archdiocese, all of which serve to make Christ known in the world.
