"Over the past recent months, there has been an explosion of cyber-related crimes and hacking incidents across the entire country, and recent analyses by cyber security professionals indicate there is a hack on a computer system every 11 seconds of every day."

Please be aware that hackers are targeting parishes that announce having a new priest or pastor. They use this cover to send spam as if from the new pastor, asking for a favor, gift cards, or money. Please disregard or report these contacts as they are not only inappropriate but illegal. Always call the parish office if you are not sure.

Here are some other email tips for your safety:

- + When you send email to a group, always use "To: BB" (Blind copy) which respectfully keeps everyone's email address private.
- + Don't open emails from someone you don't know or don't trust.
- + Avoid sending any sensitive information over email.
- + Never open an attachment within an email from a company or person you don't know, or that you were not expecting.
- + Never click on links inside emails unless you are very sure they are not spam. Use a spam filter.
