27TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

"Have no anxiety at all, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, make your requests known to God. Then the peace of God that surpasses all understanding will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 4:6)

A funny thing happens when you turn your will over to God: God takes control. For many, there is fear with the idea of someone else taking the reigns over our life's decisions. It is not our decisions per se, but how we react to life as it is. We ask: "What do I do?" Do we see that most of the decision-making process is ruled by anxiety? Let that anxiety go, by bringing God in to aid us. It is said that the average adult makes about 35,000 remotely conscious decisions per day. We need only bring God in on the important ones. Bring it to prayer, and while the decision may be a difficult one, the anxiety which surrounds the decision will dissolve into trust – not that we are absolved of the situation, but that God is truly with us. The solidarity of Jesus Christ is the great "medicine" of our faith. He will stand with us and carry us, if necessary, from one point in life to the next. It works. In his Letter to the Philippians, Saint Paul recognizes that the "peace of God surpasses all understanding" which means that the heavy load is taken on by God himself as his "yoke is easy and his burden light." Further, it is comforting to know that the Lord is at hand.... Here is a medicine to relieve grief and every bad circumstance and every pain. What is it? To pray and to give thanks in everything. He does not wish that a prayer be merely a petition but a thanksgiving for what we have received.... How can one make petitions for the future without a thankful acknowledgment of past things? ... So one ought to give thanks for everything, even what seems grievous. That is the mark of one who is truly thankful. Grief comes out of the circumstances with their demands. Thanksgiving comes from a soul that has true insight and a strong affection for God. [Saint John Chrysostom, Homily on the Philippians]

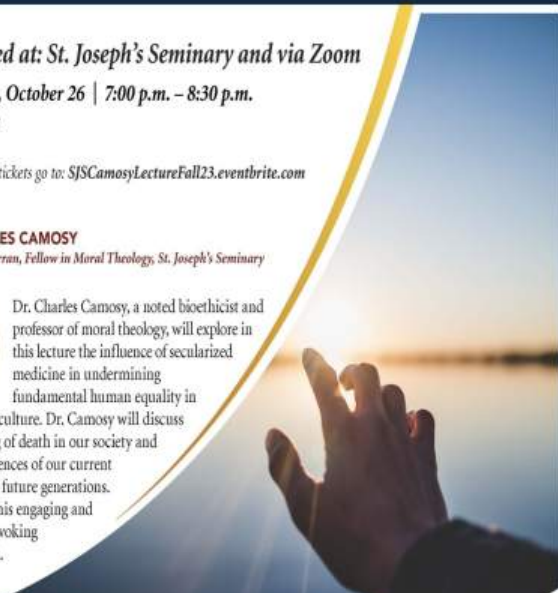

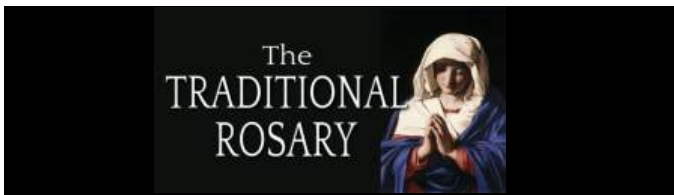
