FR. KEVIN'S REFLECTION

34TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Parishioners of both parishes keeping asking: How are you settling in to being pastor to both parishes? Here is my answer. It is difficult, but for a reason I did not expect. One of the first priorities a priest has upon entering a new assignment is to try to make it his home. This takes time.

I was assigned to Saint Peter's only a little over a year before I began to work at St. Joseph. I was just beginning to feel at home in one parish and now I am moving back and forth between two. I must ask myself: where is my home? They say: "Home is where the heart is." Well, my heart is divided between two places. I say: "Home is where the dog is." Titus doesn't know which house he will be in today or tomorrow. Sometimes neither do I.

The saints would say: "Home is where the Eucharist rests." In this case, I am very lucky. What I must come to greater terms with is accepting that my "home" is not a house or town. **According to the Gospel, my "home" should consist of a series of relationships – in a community of love and service – with God's people.**

This Sunday's Mass Readings insist that preparation for our heavenly home begins with **our home on earth – this "home" reflecting the care and concern we share for others as Jesus Christ is in them as he is in us.** The saints have a lot to say about seeing Christ in others and the extent to which we do, or fail to understand this reality greatly impacts our relationship with God: *"For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, a stranger and you welcomed me, naked and you clothed me, ill and you cared for me, in prison and you visited me."* (Matthew 25:35)

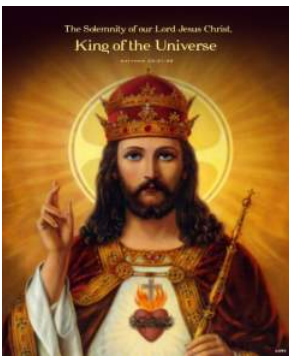
This prayer invoking the Holy Spirit upon the bread and wine on the altar is also a powerful moment reminding us of our need for His help.

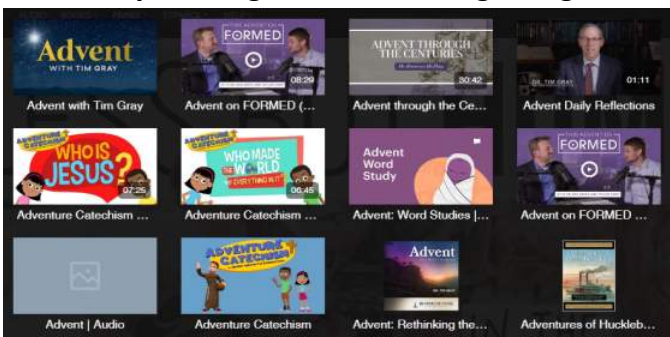

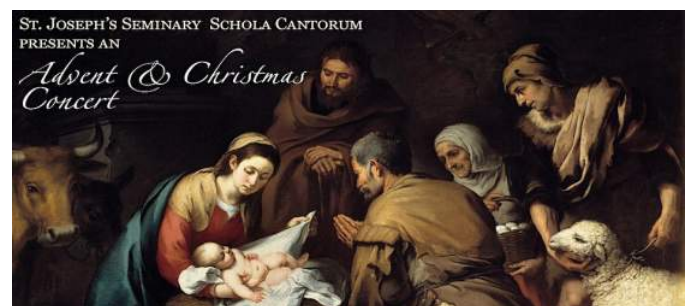
