THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT

**“Destroy this temple and in three days I will
raise it up.” John 2:19**



“...what was Jesus doing on the Temple Mount as he turned over the tables and announced the destruction of the Temple. He was not simply a radical, protesting against the political and religious establishment. He was reiterating the prophetic judgments of Isaiah and Ezekiel against the corruption of Israelite worship; but even more than this, he was acting in the very person of Yahweh who had come to cleanse his temple and to make it a place of true adoratio. Even the most vociferous of the prophets wanted only to reform the Temple, but Jesus declared that he would tear it down — and then re-establish it in his own body: ‘in three days I will raise it up’. In these words he was drawing out the logical implication of his earlier statement ‘something greater than the temple is here’ (Mt 12:6), telling the people that the entire purpose of the earlier temple would be transfigured in him, transposed, as it were, into a new key. He himself would be the place where faithful Israel and faithful Yahweh would come together.”
