MOTHER'S DAY ~ SUNDAY, MAY 12



In the United States, the first Mother's Day was celebrated by Anna Jarvis in 1908 in honor of her late mother, who organized women's groups to promote friendship and health. In 1914, President Woodrow Wilson proclaimed Mother's Day a

national holiday to be held on the second Sunday of May. While Mother's Day in the United States is a secular holiday, the Catholic Church has been celebrating the original "Mothering Sunday" since the earliest years of the Church.

The original Mother's Day, "Mothering Sunday," is a pious Catholic tradition that started in the earliest days of the Church and took place on Laetare Sunday, the fourth Sunday in the liturgical season of Lent.

Laetare Sunday is a more celebratory day in the otherwise austere Lenten season. On this day, people would pay a visit and return to their *mother* Church where they were baptized, otherwise their local parish church or the nearest cathedral (the mother church to all churches in the diocese.) Those that returned to their mother Church on Mothering Sunday were said to have gone "a-mothering."

The 1962 Roman Missal marks the day with a sense of maternal love, a love for the Holy Mother Church and Mary as the Mother of God and all Catholics.

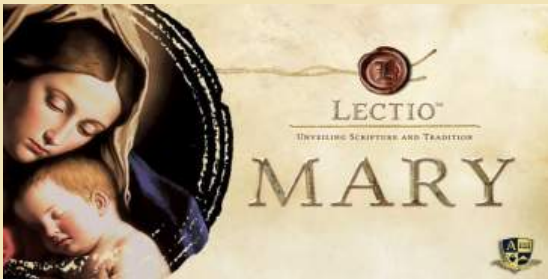
MASS TIMES REVISION
