PENTECOST

Celebrating the Holy Spirit's role in launching the Church, Pentecost takes place on the seventh Sunday (50th day) after Easter. It follows the Ascension, where Jesus ascended into heaven and was no longer physically present with his disciples.

Before he left the disciples, Jesus told them, "And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age," (Mt 28:20). The 11 remaining Apostles returned to Jerusalem after the Ascension of Jesus into Heaven. During this time, the Apostles chose a replacement for Judas Iscariot. They cast lots between two men, and the lot fell on Matthias. "All these with one accord devoted themselves to prayer, together with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brethren." Acts 1:14

After nine days of prayer, as the disciples were gathered in the upper room with others (a group of about 120 total), the Holy Spirit descended upon them. They heard a sound like a "mighty wind," and "tongues as of fire" were resting on their heads. Acts 2:2-4 Those gathered saw this as their baptism "with the Holy Spirit," as Jesus had promised and recognized this as their commissioning to be Jesus's witnesses "to the ends of the earth." This is why Pentecost is known as the birth of the Church.

Going out, Peter spoke to the crowd that had gathered. Even though, just a few weeks earlier, he had denied Christ three times, Peter courageously proclaimed the Gospel. That day, three thousand people believed in Christ and were received into His Church.
