Jesus speaks to us about the kingdom of God in this week's Gospel. We often tend to think He is referring to heaven, but this is usually not the case. The kingdom of God includes all His domain: heaven and earth. We aren't meant to do things *now for later*, but rather to be virtuous and faith-filled *for now and later*. As Christians, we are meant to live one day at a time, because the Holy Spirit can only sanctify us in the present moment.

We often find ourselves consumed with the past and future, but it is the present moment that God uses to breathe life into us and draw us closer to Him. Understood in this way, our experience of God must begin now, culminating in the eternity of heaven, in which sin, suffering, and death no longer have power over us. Jesus wants us to focus on the *now* because the more our lives are faith and virtue driven, the greater glory is given to the Father in His creation, which so often seeks to praise God, but rather denigrate the gifts of love He showers upon us through sin.

*If we're spiritually minded, we tend to think of salvation as an escape from this world – this vale of tears – to a disembodied state called "heaven." The problem is that these convictions have far more to do with Plato than with the Bible. Biblical cosmology is not fundamentally dualistic. It speaks indeed of "heaven" and "earth," but it sees these two realms as interacting and interpenetrating fields of force. Heaven, the arena of God and the angels, touches upon and calls out to earth, the arena of humans, animals, plants, and planets. On the biblical reading, salvation, therefore, is a matter of the meeting of heaven and earth, so that God might reign as thoroughly here below as he does on high. [Vibrant Paradoxes: The Both/And of Catholicism, 2016]*

So what if we start off with the size of the mustard seed? God waters us with grace to grow and become the largest of plants.
