From the Pastor



The true Christian has never been wholly comfortable in the world. Jesus was and is counter cultural. The disciple, being truly honest, must either hide who they are or become an outcast to varying degrees among others. Popular opinion is no longer rooted in religious values and so those with religious values are ostracized. This should neither surprise nor cause worry. With few exceptions over the long road of civilizations rising and falling this has always been the case. It is always more enjoyable to be a part of the "in" crowd but let us remember that Jesus was popular in his ministry only for a short while. He often caused listeners to fall away because His words were too much for their sensitivity and comfort. Jesus preached God's righteousness, and it is to this standard that we are held. Therefore, as Saint Paul says, "do not continue in ignorance but try to understand what is the will of the Lord. And do not get drunk on wine, in which lies debauchery, but be filled with the Spirit" (Ephesians 5) ... I have been sober from alcohol for five years. When I would drink alcohol, it was rarely to be social. I used it as an escape, if only for a short while, to be ignorant of my troubles and the troubles of others. But the sobriety to which Saint Paul calls us to for the sake of the Gospel and our discipleship is a sobriety from cultural bias against religious values. This bias causes in us a desire to curl up into a ball and hide. Rather we must seek to understand the will of God for us in our lives amid so much adversity. We must not allow ourselves to be swayed by what is easy, but rather by what is true – for it is the Truth alone that will set you free.
