**FROM THE
Pastor...**



As always, it is an interesting election season. That which I always find interesting during political debates and media propaganda is how little candidates or political parties will actually advertise what they stand for and how much effort they will spend deflecting or ignoring questions. Most effort is placed on demonizing the opponent. Why do you suppose that is? It has been proven historically and scientifically from a psychological perspective that it is much easier to rally support for hatred than for love. How was Hitler able to garner support against the Jewish population of Europe from a German citizenry that was 50% Roman Catholic and 50% Lutheran? Finding a common enemy on which we can scapegoat our problems has been a part of our humanity since the beginning. Consider the story from the Book of Genesis about Adam and Eve. God realizes Adam has eaten from the tree of knowledge. Does Adam take responsibility for it? No. He blames both Eve and God Himself (as He was the one who put her with him) for his problems. Every time you turn on the News or scroll through Facebook, recognize the demonization of others. This is a prevalent theme in our scripture readings this weekend. *Where do the wars and where do the conflicts among you come from? Is it not from your passions that make war within your members? You covet but do not possess. You kill and envy but you cannot obtain; you fight and wage war. You do not possess because you do not ask. You ask but do not receive, because you ask wrongly, to spend it on your passions. (James 3)*

Saint James was instrumental in his ancient writings defining just what it means to be a Christian. We are all welcome to our own opinions, but be careful because demonizing another through slander or gossip is inexcusable, un-Christian behavior.
