FROM THE Pastor...



"So the Lord God cast a deep sleep on the man, and while he was asleep, he took out one of his ribs and closed up its place with flesh. The Lord God then built up into a woman the rib that he had taken from the man." (Genesis 2) This is one of the most misunderstood pericopes of Scripture. Many believe it is a reflection on the dominance of man over woman in the sense that Eve was taken from Adam to be created. We must take into context the cultural setting from which this lesson develops. In fact, it is a spiritual and sociological reflection on marriage. By putting Adam to sleep, God takes authority away from man (the male part) and places the ordering of relationship between man and woman (the female part) above societal decisions. Within ancient cultures, the region of the body that one is focused on is of great significance. The crown of the head reflects superiority. The heel of the foot reflects inferiority. In military or quasi-military institutions, an inferior member salutes the superior officer by placing the hand on the brow of the head and salutes in an upward motion indicating the importance or authority of the other. However, an insult to another person would be to point downwards towards the ground in which the heel of the foot is in constant contact with the ground on which the serpent slithers. When Jesus sends his disciples out two-by-two, he instructs them to shake the dust from their sandals in testimony against anyone who rejects them, using the lowest part of the body to reflect their inferior desires for holiness and truth. In the story, if God had taken a piece of the crown of Adam's skull to create Eve, her superiority to Adam would be revealed. If God had taken the heel or a part of the foot for Eve, she would be inferior to Adam. Rather, God takes Adam's rib, equal from top to bottom, indicating that Adam and Eve, man and woman, husband and wife, are equal to each other. Throughout history, cultures have been both Patriarchal and Matriarchal, but from the beginning it was not so. The first lesson of the Bible establishes God's existence and authority; the second humanity's equality of the sexes.
