Dear Friends,

These early weeks as pastor of Sacred Heart have offered me many opportunities to get to know how things work here and who does the work! I am really very impressed with the generosity and spirit of service of so many of you!

Now we begin Stage Two: *The Meetings!*

As August unfolds, so too do many "first meetings" to begin working with the various councils and committees that supply the planning and energy to so many of our programs. Soon, I will be meeting with the parish's Pastoral Council and the Liturgy Committee, and we already have on the schedule an important "workshop" for those who bring Holy Communion to our sick and homebound. I already met with Mark Selle, principal of Cataldo School and was given the "grand tour" of the school and invited to participate in its ministry in a number of ways.

Another very important meeting took place last week; as many of you know Sacred Heart and St. Augustine's have shared for some years our youth ministry programs for both junior and senior high. Jeanette Benson, who served for several years as director of those programs, has a new full-time position at St. Mary's in the Spokane Valley, so Father Dublinsky, Father Mejia, and I, as well as Sue Harmon, Pastoral Minister from St. Augustine's and our own Paul Macias from Sacred Heart met last week to make plans for a new youth ministry program for our three parishes (Fatima will be new to the effort this year!). Caring for our young people's growth in faith is an essential ministry, so as Fr. Dublinsky said, "Doing nothing is not an option!" That is something we all fully agreed with!

Together we sketched the outlines of our new youth ministry program and agreed on how we will finance it. Another thing we agreed upon is that we will run the program as a volunteer effort with Sue Harmon acting as coordinator. (Already, one of my "Catholic Cougs" from WSU now working in Spokane, has offered to help out!) Further, all of us pastors committed ourselves to being as present to the kids as possible throughout the year. If you might like to help us out at either level, please let me know! If you know of someone you think would be good at this kind of ministry, please invite them to consider joining us!

As Father Dublinsky said so perfectly, when it comes to our kids, "doing nothing is not an option!" Let's do far more than nothing for our kids; let's give them our best!
