Dear Friends,

Well, this Bulletin will have to last you the month! There is so little going on during the summer months that it is just not worth the work of putting out an issue every Sunday...we hope you don't mind!

On July 18th, I'll be heading out for my own summer vacation. This year, I'm going first to Spain where I will be ministering to pilgrims along the Camino as they walk their way to Santiago de Compostela. No walking for me this time; I am looking forward to "paying forward" so much of the kindness and hospitality I was given as I walked by doing something of the same for others.

Following my days in Spain, I'll fly up to Belgium for our seminary reunion in Leuven (Louvain). It is probably the last one we will have there, now that our beloved building and gardens have been turned over the University. We will be able to gather there for some events, including Mass together in our grand little chapel.

Just before I leave, we will be celebrating here at Sacred Heart our second Feast of Saint James the Apostle. As last year, we will have Mass including a blessing of new pilgrims, followed by a fun dinner in the social hall. Last year, we were expecting maybe 60 participants but ended up with over 220; this year we are planning on 300, but who knows how many "pilgrims" we will be hosting this year. We do know it will be fun and even more, be an opportunity for many people from many disparate backgrounds to share together the spirit of Santiago (that's Spanish for Saint James) and the pilgrim experience. You, of course, are invited to join us and get a "feel" for that experience and spirit.

When I get back in mid-August, I'll have a story or two to tell, I presume. I hope I'll get home reasonably rested and certainly ready for the new year!

I hope, too, that each of you has time in these months to rest, relax, and be refreshed in the Lord, wherever you find yourselves, even if it is only home. While I'm in Spain and Belgium, I will keep you in my prayers and invite you to do the same for me!
