

## While Father is Away...

Knowing that he would be away when this Bulletin would need to be prepared, Father Kevin has invited a guest columnist to offer us a few thoughts for the weeks of August...

Hail Dear People of God!

I like that word, "Hail!" I remember it well from when I was just a very young person. I had a dream and that was the first word I heard come from the golden mouth of a white angel, all feather and fluff. Well, actually, the angel looked more like the neighbor boy to me than one of those cartoon angels so popular on Christmas cards these days. No golden smile, but he did have a cute smile and his bangs were a bit disordered over his forehead, and his "hail" was kind of shyly spoken, not loud or trumpety. That was the beginning; I think you know the story and what came of that dream. It took on flesh in rather startling and godly ways, as you remember.

The end of the story, but hardly the end of the dream, came with my boy, by then grown into a Godly man, being led to his death by other men overcome with jealousy and fear. No mother should have to watch her boy be treated in such a way...no mom should have to behold the last breath of her son. But what can one do if that is what others have in their hearts? Nor is that the end of the dream, as you have heard: my boy walked out of his tomb and quietly and kind of shyly said to his friends, *Shalom*, "Peace!" And so it was, so it is, that a new kind of peace found a small place in the hearts of you all...and me. *God Peace*. That's what I now call it. It calms fear. It melts jealousy. It nourishes hope. It propagates forgiveness. It nurtures love: *God Love*. That was my son, if I think about it: he was, well he IS, just that: *God Love*.

Later on, long after that first First Day of the Week, I had another dream. The same young boy who turned out to be an angel visited me again in my deep dotage. Again, he said his shy little *Hail*. His dark bangs still hung crooked and his smile was just as sweet. This time, he said simply, "It is time to come home." And then he wrapped his arms around my creaky old bones, and once again, dream became flesh, or maybe it was more like the flesh became dream, but the true kind of dream, the dream that is *God Dream*. And so I found myself in the arms of my boy.

He cuddling me as I once cuddled him.

When the moment is right, that neighbor boy kind of angel will visit you also and your flesh will become *God Dream*, too, and He will be your brother and I will be your sister...forever. We are looking forward to that. We hope you are, too.
