

## A Word from Father



Dear Friends,

The demands of domestic life are still a bit new to me! Owing my own home, (through the generosity of my parents, who “sold” me their little house on the Northside for \$1 many years ago), brings concerns and preoccupations that I didn't have prior to being a “homeowner.” Most of them are simple and easily adopted into my lifestyle, like mowing the lawn more or less regularly or keeping the window trim painted. In other areas, I am still learning; I planted three tomato plants in the spring and now that they are producing their lovely fruit in great quantity, I have no idea what to do with the hundreds of cherry tomatoes that weigh down those plants' branches! I give away plenty, but still have more and haven't had the time to make salsa or whatever...so they sit on my countertop with the countdown to being overripe ticking away.

One that I've been working on but haven't exactly solved yet, is what to do with tree branches I've pruned, bunches of dead grass and weeds that I've cleaned out of the flower bed, and other “stuff” that I just need to ditch. For awhile I could borrow my brother's pick-up to haul it off to the incinerator plant, but he has a new one now with a canopy so it is a “trip to the dump” kind of truck. So my pile of domestic detritus grows while I ponder a solution.



One thing I've been thinking about is getting my own pickup, but I don't want to take on any debt to do it; here's the rub: looking at the stickers on new trucks makes my eyes water, and most of the used ones listed in Wheel Deals are still priced WAAAY beyond my

budget. But I choose to remain patient as I continue to peruse the pages of Wheel Deals and the Want-Ads for that perfectly aged pick-up that has been reasonably well-cared for, isn't rusting out, doesn't guzzle gas or burn oil, and, most of all is priced somewhere south of \$1500. Its out there... can feel it...I just have to find it...or let it find me!
