

## A Word from Father...



Dear Friends,

As we celebrate this weekend the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, it is a good time to remember with gratitude those who serve in the "healing professions." All of us sooner or later, find that our bodies, wonderful gift that they are, fail us in one way or another. Illness is just part of the human condition and none of us stay young forever. It is when we are sick that we really come to appreciate those who care for us in so many ways, from our family and friends who prepare oodles of chicken soup for us when we have the flu, or more seriously, become our "caretakers" so that we can remain at home when more serious and prolonged illness afflicts us. From our primary care physicians and their team of health professionals who form the first line of defense when we are not well, to the more specialized doctors who care for us when something really important goes wrong. Their extraordinary knowledge and skill are brought to bare to protect us from the worst and bring us back to health. Our hospital and nursing facility chaplains likewise do so much to relieve anxiety and remind us that especially in pain and illness, God is near. And what a blessing are all those who serve in hospice care! Their beautiful work in caring in every way for the whole person in their final days or weeks of life is really a ministry of mercy and love.

Even with all the obvious faults in our "health system," we nevertheless are the beneficiaries of extraordinarily dedicated health professionals whose commitment to our care is often inspiring. We have every reason to be very grateful to all of them!

Caring for one another, especially when ill, is one of our great values as followers of Christ, and it is one that all of us are called to in one way or another. It is with the desire to further fulfil our own commitment to care for one another that we recently installed two AED machines to our parish buildings and will be offering simple training in how to use them next month (*see announcement to the left*). They are simple to use and can save lives...I hope you'll join us in this brief training session during coffee and doughnuts.
