News from Cataldo...

Did you know that Cataldo Catholic School supports Cataldo families with quality child care before school, after school, and during the summer?



Cataldo's child care program, Cataldo Care, is licensed by the Washington Department of Children, Youth, and Families, and operates out of the preschool classrooms in the basement of the school. During the school year, we provide children from preschool - junior high before school and after school care with outside play, games, crafts, homework assistance, and other fun activities. The seamless connection between our students' teachers, their after school activities, and their families is something we are very proud of.

During the summer, Cataldo provides another licensed program to children who are enrolled at Cataldo for the following school year. From June 17th through August 21st, Cataldo Summer Care provides fun activities including Art Day and Water Day, as well as field trips and neighborhood adventures, from 6:55 am to 5:00 pm. Each week has a theme, such as Ice Cream, Pool Noodle Fun, or Pirates and Princesses. The program is run by Lindsey Morse, Cataldo Care Director, as well as many amazing staff members who work in the Cataldo Preschool and in Cataldo Care during the school year.





A Word from Father...



Dear Friends,

As you know from the box to the left, we have exceeded our goal for the 50th Anniversary Fund and the two primary projects are now moving ahead because of your generosity.

Let me update you a bit on how things are going:

We have signed the agreements with our contractors for both major projects. Elmer Construction will be overseeing the bathroom project and Pro-Mechanical will be doing the heating-air conditioning work; both companies are local to Spokane.

In advance of the bathroom renovations we have already had asbestos floor tiles removed from the area that will be the ladies' room and have had the sewer lines below the floor located and their depth documented (notice the duck-tape on the floor with numbers? ...please don't remove it!)

On the heating/air-conditioning front, the order for the equipment has been placed and the first outdoor work was begun this past week: setting the foundations for the concrete slab that will support the outdoor equipment (located just outside the east door of the church near the present furnace room).

Work on both projects will begin in earnest on June 10th. Due to the work as it progresses, we may have to move some liturgies to the Social Hall, but only if safety requires it. We'll let you know as soon as we know and will make it as easy as possible for everyone.

Again, we are so grateful to all of you for making this work possible!
