## A Word from Father...



Dear Friends,

This past Tuesday at a meeting of the Cataldo School Advisory Council, it was announced that Bishop Daly has authorized some administrative changes to the Board of Governors of the school, which consists of the three pastors of the parishes associated with the school. In the two years that this leadership model has been in place, it has become obvious to all concerned that the structure of the Board of Governors was making it difficult to respond to the needs of the school administration in a nimble and clear manner.

Under the new system, the Board of Governors itself will continue to meet quarterly (rather than monthly), but responsibilities for a number of its functions will be handled by just one of the three pastors. Both Father Mee of Saint Augustine and Father Connell of the Cathedral have substantial responsibilities in the diocese beyond their parish responsibilities as diocesan vicars, so Bishop Daly asked me to take on the new responsibilities at Cataldo, which I agreed to. I enjoy visiting the children and celebrating with them their student liturgies; I have a very good working relationship with the principal, Mr. Zack Cunningham, and feel a great dedication to the ministry of Catholic education, having been formed by it virtually my whole life.

The particular responsibilities I will exercise on behalf of the Board of Governors going forward include these:



- ◆ I will be responsible for the regular supervision of the principal as well as overseeing his annual evaluation.
- ◆ As requested by the principal, I will also meet with the teaching staff for in-services or other meetings.
- ◆ I will be responsible for signing teaching contracts.
- ◆ I will represent the Board of Governors at School Advisory Council (SAC) meetings.
- ◆ Parental concerns and conflict resolution not resolved with the principal will be referred on to me.
- ◆ Public relations regarding the Board of Governors will also be handled by me.

I personally look forward to assisting Cataldo Catholic School, its staff, students, and parents in fulfilling both its religious and its academic mission on behalf of our three parishes and hope that my input and counsel will be wise and helpful as the school community grows in the faith and love that is the hallmark of Jesus' own mission among us.
