A Word from Father. "In Loving Memory"



Dear Friends,

During this uniquely challenging time of special caution during the COVID-19 pandemic, we are limited in how we usually remember our beloved dead, so we have to be creative in finding new ways to do so. Here at Sacred Heart, our parish Liturgy Committee invites you to participate in a special way to honor and pray for those who have gone before us. It is called the "In Loving Memory Project"; we will be preparing a video to play on both our parish website and our Facebook page that commemorates the wonderful people we wish to remember in November. It will be available, hopefully, on November 2nd, the feast of All Souls and throughout the month of November. This is how it will work:

- —You send to us basic information about each of the persons you wish to have prayerfully remembered.
 - +A photo of each person, if possible
 - +The dates of birth and death of each person
 - +The person's relationship to you, (for example: mother, sister, brother, friend)
 - +Any *brief* comments about the person that we might add. (For example: "John was a loving father to his children and spent his life as a giving and forgiving person. He was a blessing to us all.")
- —There is no limit on the number of persons you can have remembered, but priority will be given to those most recently deceased.
- —You may send us this information by regular mail, (any photos included will be returned), email (please attach digital photos), or by dropping off the information at the parish office.
