

## Church Safety Updates:

With the changes in the covid-19 situation both nationally and locally, as well as Bishop Daly's announcement of the end of his dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass, our Sacred Heart Parish Safety Committee that has been guiding our decisions about safety precautions has announced the following updated protocols:



- ◆ We will no longer be advance registering or signing in for our parish liturgies, nor will we maintain attendance limits.
- ◆ We will maintain our every-other pew distancing in the church.
- ◆ We will no longer require masks *for those who have been FULLY VACCINATED*. We ask the fully vaccinated to continue to maintain appropriate social distancing.
- ◆ Those who have not yet been fully vaccinated (completed vaccinations & *two weeks*) or who have chosen not to receive the vaccinations *must continue to wear masks* in church and outside the church. We will not be verifying vaccination status, but will rely on you to follow "the honor system" in complying.
- ◆ For the time being, we will continue to bring Holy Communion to you *in the pews*. Please continue to receive the Blessed Sacrament in your *open hand only*.
- ◆ For the time being, Deacon Brian will continue to offer Holy Communion outside following the weekend liturgies.
- ◆ The Holy Water fonts will be available soon.
- ◆ Hymn books and offering envelopes will be returned to the pews.
- ◆ The offering collection will be restored as soon as our ushers can get it organized.
- ◆ At the request of the Diocese of Spokane, we will not restore the physical Sign of Peace or Communion from the Cup at this time.
- ◆ Livestreaming of the 10:00 am Sunday Mass will continue through the summer months.
- ◆ Other parish liturgies, such as funerals, will follow these revised protocols.
- ◆ Funeral receptions or similar activities may be allowed either outside or indoors, as long as the vulnerable and unvaccinated are masked and maintain social distancing.

Thank you, as always, for your cooperation, perseverance, and care for one another during this pandemic. Let us continue to pray for its end both here and around the world.
