Church Safety Updates:

With the changes in the covid-19 situation both nationally and locally, as well as Bishop Daly's announcement of the end of his dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass, our safety protocols have been revised and updated. Following is an abbreviated version (full version can be found on our website):



- ◆ Advance registration or signing in for our parish liturgies are no longer required, nor will we maintain attendance limits.
- ◆ We will maintain our every-other pew distancing in the church.
- ◆ **We will no longer require masks for those who have been FULLY VACCINATED. We ask the fully vaccinated to continue to maintain appropriate social distancing.**
- ◆ **Those who are not yet fully vaccinated (completed vaccinations & two weeks) or who have chosen not to receive the vaccinations must continue to wear masks in church and outside the church. We will not be verifying vaccination status, but will rely on you to follow "the honor system" in complying.**
- ◆ For the time being, we will continue to bring Holy Communion to you *in the pews*. Please continue to receive the Blessed Sacrament in your *open hand only*.
- ◆ For the time being, Deacon Brian will continue to offer Holy Communion outside following the weekend liturgies.
- ◆ The offering collection will be restored as soon as our ushers can get it organized.
- ◆ At the request of the Diocese of Spokane, we will not restore the physical Sign of Peace or Communion from the Cup at this time.
- ◆ Livestreaming of the 10:00 am Sunday Mass will continue through the summer months.

Thank you, as always, for your cooperation, perseverance, and care for one another during this pandemic. Let us continue to pray for its end both here and around the world.

Dear Friends,

It has been a few weeks now since I announced to you that I would soon be retiring and entering that oddly named status of "senior priest" of our diocese.

One of the most common responses has been the simplest: "We are glad for you, but sad for us." I might add, that has also been one of the most touching to me for I share exactly that two-fold sentiment.
