In this weekend’s gospel, we find St. Luke’s version of the beatitudes - the road to a blessed life.

As Jesus outlined the beatitudes for us, St. Luke the evangelist makes note of the fact that Jesus was standing on level ground.

We will never go wrong when we make a conscious effort of being grounded; that is, having our feet planted on the earth and our hearts and minds raised up to heaven. The spiritual life assumes that position! When we stay grounded in the Word of God and live the beatitudes, we are definitely on the road to heaven and counted now among the blessed!


Let’s stay grounded in our faith together!
