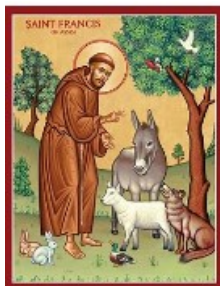
Many of you have been making regular donations to your CRS Rice Bowl during the Lenten season, and we are most grateful for your participation!

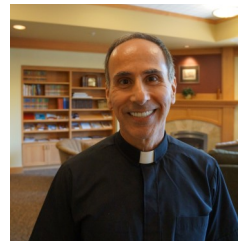
Blue Envelope Fund

Grief Share: Support for Those Grieving the Loss of a Loved One

GriefShare is a 13-week support group program that offers advice and encouragement on different grief-related subjects through videos presented by trained counselors and people who have grieved the loss of



loved ones. Each participant receives a workbook with short scripture-based daily meditations that they are encouraged to use to help deepen their relationship with God and to receive His healing help. The weekly sessions feature 35-40 minute videos followed by a time of sharing. GriefShare group leaders are trained as facilitators, but they are not professional counselors. They are simply people who accompany others who walk the journey of grief as they themselves have. All GriefShare groups must be church sponsored.
