**Robbie Burnett** Robbie graduated from Gonzaga Prep High School with a 3.5 gpa, and will be attending WSU in the Fall.



## Pope Francis Names Ten New Saints

On May 15th, 2022, ten new saints were canonized. The fourth of these new saints is **St. Luigi Maria Palazzolo**, who lived from 1827-1886.



A priest of the Italian diocese of Bergamo, St. Luigi Maria was beatified by another one-time priest of the same diocese, Pope St. John XXIII. The youngest of eight boys, St. Luigi Maria's early life brought various difficulties, including his father's death when he was 10 years old. This experience no doubt made his heart ache for children without parents, to whom he dedicated much of his life's work. Luigi Maria estab-

lished a number of orphanages, including the Little House of Divine Providence and the Work of St. Dorothy to care for abandoned girls. And with the help of Venerable Maria Teresa Gabrieli, Luigi Maria established the Sisters of the Poor (Palazzolo Institute). St. Luigi Maria's life was defined by a commitment to give of himself in whatever capacity was needed to help others have a better life. He died repeating "Jesus Christ," whom he served so faithfully among the poor and forgotten.
