Just a friendly reminder and word of caution about lighting our votive candles: please place spent matches or other wooden lighting sticks in the pots of sand, located on the shelf underneath the candles. **Please, please, please—do not place spent matches or any other debris in the votive holders!** The debris eventually lights from the candle flame, and then promptly melts the plastic and shatters the glass votive holder. Dear Friends,

Just a few things to keep in mind as we begin the fall season:

1. Beginning on Wednesday, October 12th, at 6 pm in the Parish Hall, we will begin an Adult Education Video Series called the *Catholicism Project* by Bishop Robert Barron. There are 10 videos. We will show the first five in the fall and will pick up the last 5 early next year. The classes should run from 1 - 1/2 hours. I know you will enjoy them! Deacon Brian and I will lead the classes.
2. Sacramental Preparation Classes will begin in mid-October. Please contact the parish office if you know of someone who is 2nd grade and older and needs sacramental prep training. We will begin with the Sacrament of Reconciliation. This will be followed up with Eucharist and Confirmation classes beginning in early 2023.
3. Please let Deacon Brian know if you know of someone who is interested in becoming Catholic. There are inquiry and faith formation classes to assist someone who wants to learn more about the faith.

Speaking of Deacon Brian, I want to extend my deepest thanks to him as he has, once again, taken the lead in raising money for the Rectory project. It was a heavy blow to us when it was discovered that the Rectory site was built on land fill. This resulted in a huge, unexpected expense. Along with Brian, I am also sorry (very sorry) about this.

Many thanks for those of you who have thus far contributed to the Rectory project and the Annual Catholic Appeal. Your generosity is deeply appreciated.

It was great seeing names on the sign-up sheets during Stewardship Weekend! Thanks to everyone who volunteered to share in various ministries.
