



The Pastor's Corner



Dear Friends,

Lent is within reach; Ash Wednesday is this coming Wednesday.

We will have two Masses on Ash Wednesday: 8:30 am and 5:30 pm.

Ash Wednesday, as you recall, is a day of fasting and abstaining from meat.

Fasting (on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday): one full meal and two smaller meals that do not equal the one full meal. This applies to those from age 18-58.

Abstaining from meat: This applies to those age 14 and older. Please remember that this applies to all Fridays during the Season of Lent.

Those excused from the above regulations could be those who are pregnant, those who are manual laborers, and those who are sick. They are encouraged to take us some other form of penance, or some act(s) of piety or charity.

There are countless ways to honor God during Lent by way of some sacrifice(s). Pick one that you can feel proud of that will truly honor God.

St. John Paul II, for instance, saw Lent as an opportunity to *empty ourselves in Christian charity*, which is one way of saying: How can I be of service to the poor, the sick, the aged, the outcast?

As with everything we do, do it for the glory of God!
