A Letter from Bishop Daly:



One of the important penitential elements of Lent is the obligation of abstinence from meat on Friday. By this practice, we share in some small way in the sacrifice of Christ on the cross.

This year, the celebration of St. Patrick's Day happens to fall on Fri-

day, March 17th. For many of the faithful of eastern Washington, there is a spiritual and emotional connection with this 5th century Apostle of Ireland. He is the patron saint for a number of our parishes and we have a long history of being served by the Irish clergy.

For these reasons, I have judged it would serve the spiritual good of the faithful to grant a dispensation from the obligation to abstain from meat on March 17, 2023. This dispensation applies to all the faithful of the Diocese of Spokane as well as any visitors who may be present in the diocese on that day.


