The best days of Lent are around the corner! We'll soon be moving into Holy Week. But before that, can I highlight two upcoming opportunities?

First, this coming **Tuesday, the 28**th, the Chrism Mass will be celebrated at Our Lady of Lourdes Cathedral. The Mass begins at 5:30 pm. All the priests throughout the diocese will be there and the laity are encouraged to attend.



The bishop blesses the oils that will be used for the various sacraments during the year. I will bring the blessed oils with me after that Mass and they will be presented at our Holy Thursday Mass, which is on **April 6**th.

Second, we will have our Lenten Reconciliation Service on **Wednesday**, the **29**th, at 5:30 p.m. It is a wonderful opportunity to receive the graces of the sacrament before Easter!

Just a final word: persevere in your personal Lenten observances! You are doing it for the Lord, which is your holy sacrifice that is pleasing in his sight!
