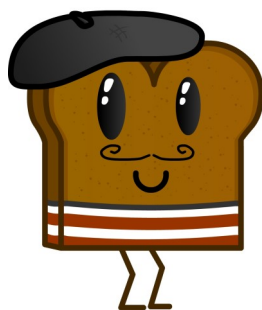

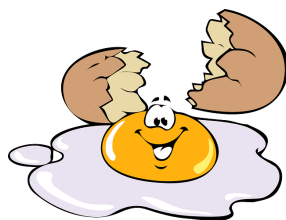
Sign up for our Parish Breakfast, April 30th!

April: National Child Abuse Prevention Month

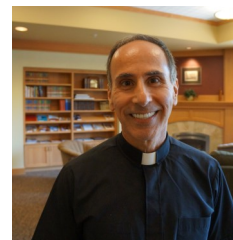

The Pastor's Corner



Dear Friends,

Last Sunday I spoke briefly about the correct posture at Mass during the Eucharistic Prayer as others mentioned to me that there was inconsistency as to when to stand and when to kneel.

According to the General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM) #43:

"In the dioceses of the United States of America, they (the faithful) should kneel beginning after the singing or recitation of the *Sanctus (Holy, Holy, Holy)* until after the *Amen* of the Eucharistic Prayer, except when prevented on occasion by ill health, or for reasons of lack of space, of the large number of people present, or for another reasonable cause."

We, of course, kneel after the *Agnus Dei (Lamb of God)* – like you already do.

I'm looking forward to the Cataldo School Auction this Saturday evening (April 22nd) and supporting our beloved grade school. I hope it is a roaring success in every way!
