

Dear Friends,

During the last week of June around 50 young high school students attended the Quo Vadis Day camp that was held at Deer Lake. These young Catholic men came together to pray, do usual "camp things," and get to know fellow faith-filled students and other priests of the diocese. The theme this year was "hope." And the takeaway message for these young men is that they place their hope and trust in God who will make know to them their vocation in life.

We are a people of hope! Hope is one of the three theological virtues (faith and charity are the other two) and we ask for increase of these three virtues at the beginning of each rosary we pray. Ask and you shall receive, says the Lord. Jesus loves to grant the good gifts we pray for.


