Word from our Office of Evangelization is that registrations for Expo'23 is off to a great start!

This event will take place on **Sunday, September 10**th. Registration is free but everyone needs to register for the event. You can find more details and order tickets at expo23.org. Registrants will receive an e-ticket (receipt), that will need to be presented at the Podium for admission to the event.

We are gearing up for an RCIA class to begin in the fall! RCIA is the acronym for Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. This is a process/program where participants, also known as catechumens, gather to study the Gospel, nurture their relationship with God, and learn Church teachings and practices. They profess their faith in Jesus Christ and the Catholic Church and are baptized, confirmed, and receive the Eucharist. These three sacraments are known as the sacraments of initiation. This class is open to Catholics who want to deepen their understanding of the faith and for those who are already baptized yet desire to be confirmed and receive the Eucharist.




