Dear Friends in Christ,

How did November get here so quickly!

The month starts off with us remembering the saints in heaven and the following day we remember all souls who have died marked with the sign of faith. In a special way we pray and remember the souls in purgatory.

Last Sunday the month-long Synod ended with a closing Mass at St. Peter's Church in Rome. There are many reports already circulating about the Synod and there will be many things written about it in the days, weeks, and months ahead.

One beautiful takeaway was reading what Pope Francis said about the importance of spending time in Adoration. He stated that "only through silent Adoration will the Word of God live in our words; only in his presence will we be purified, transformed, and renewed by the first of his Spirit."

There you have it. The power of prayer in Adoration is transformative! Please remember that we have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on first Fridays of the month after the 8:30 Mass. And, it goes without saying, that we derive much grace and power through prayer when we pray in places other than during Adoration.

The cold season is upon us. Please dress warm and drive extra cautious in the snow and heavy rain. Now that we have re-implemented the Precious Blood at Mass, please refrain from receiving from the chalice if you are not feeling well or happen to be on the verge of catching something. I know you would refrain from receiving from the chalice in those circumstances anyway, but some reminders are worth repeating.

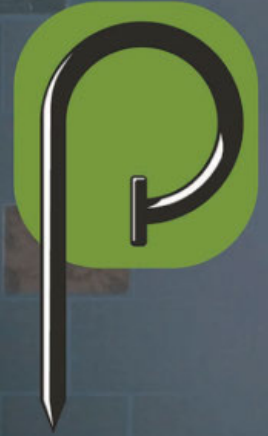

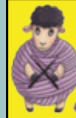

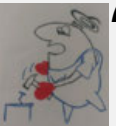
