It's once again time for our annual Tree of Sharing gift giving season. This year, our Social Concerns Committee is working with

Mother Teresa Haven "a program of Catholic Charities", which offers housing to 48 families and is located near Spokane Falls Community College. We will be providing gifts to 85 children. We will also have approximately 25 tags again this year on our Tree of Sharing for special needs adult residents of Blair House, Milford House, & L'Arche.

We thank you in advance for picking up one or several tag(s) on the tree in the church vestibule. Our goal is to provide gifts to each person for whom we have a tag. If a tag lists multiple gift ideas, you are welcome to pick only one or two of the gifts – you need not give everything on the list.

For Mother Teresa Haven gifts, these gifts will be distributed at an all family party prior to Christmas. Because everyone will be opening their gifts together, we ask you to: 1) Please choose only one selection if there are several items on the tag; 2) Please spend in the range of \$25-\$30 for each gift, so the children will receive gifts of similar value. Gift certificates should be \$25 each.

Please return your gift(s) with the tag(s) attached for the next two weekends (through December 9/10) under the tree. Thereafter, bring your gifts to the parish office -but not later than December 14th, please. Again, we are grateful for your willingness to help make Christmas special for our neighbors who have little. Your participation is truly appreciated. ## The Pastor's Corner



Dear Friends,

Not only is today the last Sunday of the month, today is also the last Sunday of our liturgical year. Remember that liturgical years begin on the first Sunday of Advent (which we'll celebrate next weekend) and they conclude on the Feast of Christ the King (which we celebrate this weekend).

A bit of history about this feast, provided by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops:

Pope Pius XI instituted this feast in 1925 with his encyclical *Quas primas* ("In the first") to respond to growing secularism and atheism. He recognized that attempting to "thrust Jesus Christ and his holy law" out of public life would result in continuing discord among people and nations. This solemnity reminds us that while governments come and go, Christ reigns as King forever.

This coming Friday, December 1<sup>st</sup>, is the first Friday of the month. One Catholic tradition that you may know about is the practice of attending Mass the first Friday of each month for 9 consecutive months, honoring the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This could be a great lesson to teach your children or grandchildren; there are many resources on the internet about this devotion!

Keep in mind that we have Exposition of the Eucharist and a holy hour after the 8:30 am Mass on First Fridays. We also join at that time to pray the rosary.

Know that I continue to be available for home visits and anointing of the sick. To assist me with home visits are faithful volunteers from the parish as well as two seminarians from Bishop White Seminary.

Please stay well and know of my prayers for you.


