We begin Ash Wednesday this Wednesday with two Masses being offered: 8:30 am and 5:30 pm.

Ash Wednesday is a day of fast and abstinence. What specifically does that mean?

For Catholics 14 years or older, that means no meat can be consumed that day. And for Catholics from the age of 18 until age 59, it means one full meal may be eaten, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

This is a noble way to offer sacrifice to God as we begin the penitential season of Lent.

At the start of the Lenten Season, I wish you all strength and grace in staying committed to your personal Lenten commitment.
