



The Pastor's Corner



Dear Friends,

We will be having our Lenten Reconciliation Service on Monday, March 25, at 5:30 pm. There will be a number of confessors joining me to hear confessions that evening.

To prepare for the sacrament, it is best to pray to the Holy Spirit to enlighten you and to help you remember what to confess. Reviewing the 10 Commandments or the Beatitudes is a good help as are sample Examination of Conscience guides that you can find in Catholic books and on Catholic websites.

Receiving the Lord's forgiveness of our sins in the Sacrament of Reconciliation is a wonderful way to prepare for Easter. It is a sacrament of love, mercy and forgiveness and not, as Pope Francis would say, a torture chamber!

It can be uncomfortable confessing your sins to a priest, but please know that he is there for you. Through his priestly ministry, he absolves your sins with these beautiful words:

"God the Father of mercies, through the death and resurrection of his Son has reconciled the world to himself and poured out the Holy Spirit for the forgives of sins;

Through the ministry of the Church may God grant you pardon and peace, and I absolve you from your sins in the name of the Father, + and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."

May God continue to grant you many blessings as you continue your Lenten journey.


