

Blue Envelope Fund Update



The Pastor's Corner

Dear Parishioners and Visitors,

Happy Easter!

What a blessing to be with you as we celebrate the saving death and resurrection of Jesus Christ – the greatest event in world history.



Lent prepared us for the Holy Week and Easter celebrations. And now the Easter story is ready to be lived out with a joyful, humble boldness.

The mission statement for the Diocese of Spokane is: *To encounter, live, and proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ.* Many employees of the diocese add that statement somewhere on each email they send out.

It all begins at the beginning: the call to <u>encounter</u> our Lord Jesus Christ, just like the Apostles and Mary of Magdala did. For us, we meet our Lord primarily through the Gospels, the sacraments, and in prayer, especially our greatest prayer, which is the Mass we pray.

Our encountering the Lord invites us to live the Christian life. We can accomplish this by respecting one another (we are the body of Christ, made in the image of God) and through acts of charity and forgiveness. These ordinary acts of love that we live out are extraordinary in the eyes of God!

To <u>proclaim</u> our Lord is to commit ourselves to be his witnesses in the world, not only in actions, but in word. To encourage someone who is struggling to put their trust in the Lord, who is truly with them, is a powerful way to witness to them. And so is telling someone you will be praying for them. And don't forget about your own faith-story. You have something important to say! Sharing your faith journey can be very edifying to someone and can inspire others to share their life with you. Those are truly sacred moments. Letting others know Jesus is truly present in our life is a magnificent witness.

At the Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday Masses, we will renew our baptismal promises, by which we once renounced sin and promised to serve God in the holy Catholic Church. We respond "*I do*" six times as we renew our promises. We will then be sprinkled with blessed water. I pray that you will feel refreshed with abundant graces at that time and throughout the entire Mass!


