The Pastor's Corner



Dear Friends,

This weekend we celebrate the great Feast of Pentecost.

Pentecost is a Greek word that literally means "fiftieth day."

On Easter we remember Jesus rising from the dead. He appeared on earth to chosen witnesses until he ascended into Heaven on the 40th day, which we celebrate as the feast of the Ascension of our Lord into Heaven. Just before the Lord ascended, he instructed his disciples to go out and proclaim the gospel to the entire world. But before doing so, he asked them to gather together in Jerusalem and pray. And so for 9 days Mary and the disciples gathered in prayer praying for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Those 9 days of prayer are what we now refer to as a "Novena."

It was on the feast of Pentecost, 50 days after Easter, that the Holy Spirit came down upon those gathered in prayer. The Church was born!

On Pentecost we ask the Holy Spirit to come into our heart and mind and renew it!

Come, Holy Spirit!

Come, Holy Spirit, renew us in mind and heart!

Come, Holy Spirit, renew the face of the earth!

Come, Holy Spirit, come!

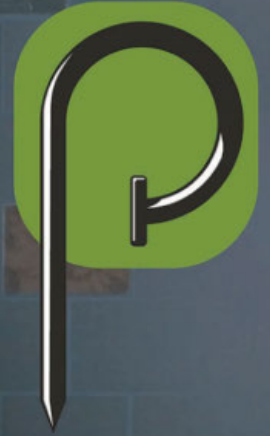

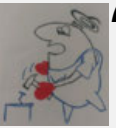
