The Pastor's Corner



Dear Friends,

We will begin hearing Gospel stories these weeks ahead which center around the Eucharist.

This past week there was a Eucharistic Revival that took place in Indianapolis. Reports tell us that 50,000 attended and, on many accounts, it was a life changing moment in the lives of many of the pilgrims.

Although we don't have to travel halfway across the country to experience that, we would be doing ourselves a great favor by recommitting our lives to Jesus Christ who is present to us very importantly in the Eucharist. Vatican 2 rightly called the Eucharist the "source and summit of the Christian life."

The Catechism of the Catholic Church (#1324) offers this beautiful insight :

The Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life." "The other sacraments, and indeed all ecclesiastical ministries and works of the apostolate, are bound up with the Eucharist and are oriented toward it. For in the blessed Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ himself, our Pasch."
