THE 1916 PROJECT

In 2019 the New York Times released *The 1619 Project* in an attempt to rewrite history on the beginnings of American slavery, highlighting the systemic racism behind the largest human rights violation in history - until now. 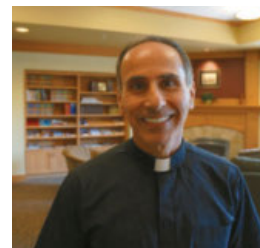

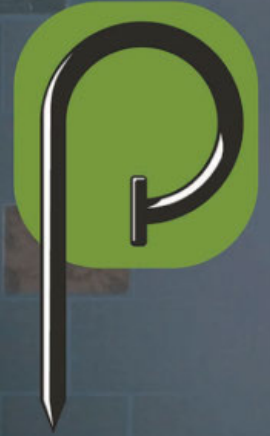

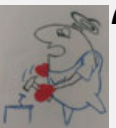
