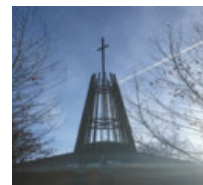

Blue Envelope Fund Update

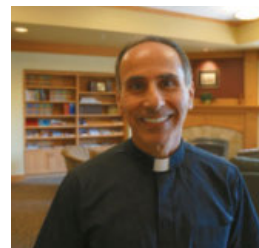
Each October, the Social Ministry Committee reviews the balance of our Outreach Funds. After careful review, the Committee allocates one time donations on behalf of the Parish to service providers who meet our guidelines and provide emergency assistance services in our community.

This year donations were given to: Catholic Charities Emergency Assistance Fund; Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Brewster (our sister Parish); HEART program for assistance to students in Grant Elementary who are in transitional or unstable housing; House of Charity for men's briefs and long johns; Sunday Lunch Program at St. Anne's Catholic Church; Buder Haven/Mother Theresa Haven for Christmas support projects.

In addition to these one time donations, our Parish also sends monthly contributions to Family Promise, Transitions for Women's Hearth, Meals on Wheels. It is through the generosity of our parishioners to the Blue Envelope Fund that we are able to make these donations. Thank you!

The first two days in November are significant. They serve to remind us of our final goal in life: Heaven.

On Friday, November 1, we celebrated All Saints Day. Not only did we remember all the Saints who are canonized, but we remember and honor all Saints who are in Heaven. 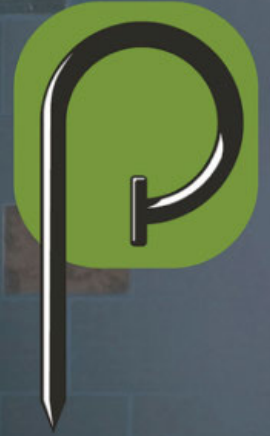
