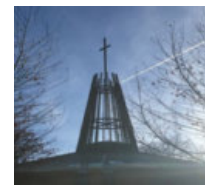

98th Annual Novena of Grace: St. Aloysius Parish, March 6th-14th.

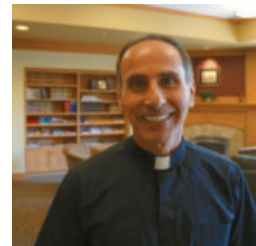

Dear Friends,

Last Sunday's parish breakfast was a huge success! It was so much fun, very well attended, and the food was wonderful! A huge thank you to Dan Veliz who spearheaded the breakfast. He had a great team working with him and each of them deserves a huge thank you as well. Many, many thanks!

This coming Wednesday, March 5th, is Ash Wednesday, which begins the season of Lent. We will have two Masses: 8:30 am and 5:30 pm. On Ash Wednesday, those people age 14 onward abstain from meat, and those from age 18 until age 59 are required to fast. Fasting means eating one full meal as well as two smaller meals that, together, are not equal to a full meal. Additionally, on Fridays during Lent we (age 14 and onward) abstain from meat.

We also begin Stations of the Cross on Fridays during Lent after the 8:30 am Mass.

It is the perfect time now to consider what you would like to do for Lent. Many people give up desserts/sweets, and some add additional prayers, devotions, or daily spiritual reading. Consider limiting time spent on social media and perform a small act of charity or self-sacrifice in its place. Decide on a Lenten sacrifice that you will be proud of and do it

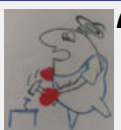
