

Dear Friends,

It is too early to ask how your Lent is going. I'll need to do a check-up with you in another week or two!

All kidding aside, we do take our Lenten Season seriously and we don't want to rush through this sacred season. Prayer and fasting are two pillars of Lent, and when you add the other pillar, Almsgiving, you have a perfect recipe!

If you can, please try to join in praying the Stations of the Cross that takes place on Fridays at 9 am - after the 8:30 morning Mass. The 14 "stations" (or "events") depict the final hours of the life of Jesus. This devotional practice helps us meditate on the Lord's suffering and sacrifice. Last year we hung new plaques beneath each Station of the Cross in our Church so anyone can easily make the "Stations" alone or with others any time before or after Mass.
